Front Lobby TV – Connecting Instructions – Marketing Computer Only

- 1. Check to make sure laptop is on 5HW WIFI
- 2. On SW-LAP1 laptop, open Air Parrot Application
 - a. This usually is slow and takes a few minutes to open
- 3. Open Front Screen Power Point Presentation located on Desktop
- 4. Create the slide you would like to present
- 5. On computer, lower right corner, select ^ sign
- 6. Select Air Parrot Icon
- 7. Wait a few moments for it to load. A pop up window should appear.
- 8. Select Lobby tv to connect to
- 9. A checkmark will appear to indicate you are connected.
- 10. If you check and it says connected but it isn't showing up on the tv, restart the computer and try again.
- 11. Go back to the presentation and click Slide Show
